Computers/AV

The need for new computers/laptops has been in the works for over five years. Chris reiterated and

followed up on the need for new computers for the club, particularly for the VP and the Treasurer. The ones currently used are having issues and will not be supported shortly. Connections have been problematic with other equipment. The club also needs a microphone and speaker box. The projector may need to be replaced as well if it keeps having powering up issues and not playing well with others.

Dan has volunteered to load the software and get the computers started.

Chris has researched several different brands and types, Dell and HP among them. The projector is easy to pair with the HP and many of our other Board members are very familiar with using the HP computers, including Chris.

Amounts for Computer and AV equipment were discussed. It was mentioned that the selling of the 5 machines from the shop equipment could be used for these purchases.

Discussion was had about pairing the computers with the projector per the manuals and double checking the need for the new projector. The suggestion was made to get the updated version of Quicken for the Treasurer's computer.

A motion was made for the club to authorize the expenditure for AV equipment, computers, and the software. The motion passed MSP.

Donations

Many institutions/charities need to receive their donations by year end.

GLMSMC usually tries to make their donation to the Smithsonian before year end so it can be used for purchasing a specimen on behalf of the GLMSMC at the Tucson Show for the Smithsonian collection. Other charities and organizations were mentioned as candidates for donations. Natural History Society of MD and Wildacres were two mentioned. (Dan and Linda just made the presentation on Wildacres.)

A motion was made to donate to the Smithsonian and to Wildacres, which was MSP.

The President asked for a committee to find out and recommend for other donations to be discussed in the future. Jonathan, Andy, and Chris volunteered to lead up the search and to report back to the Board.

Show and Budget

Chris said we had sent postcards out in years' past before the pandemic, but by last count at the show that we only had a very few returned, not making the cost of sending them out worthwhile. He also


